- Build strong partnerships with local iwi, community groups, and organizations.

- Implement regular reflection sessions with stakeholders to assess progress, challenges, and areas for growth.
- Include feedback loops to adapt strategies based on reflections.

INDIGINISING TAKARO

ENHANCED APPROACH

Develop culturally rich tākaro activities that draw from Māori traditions, stories, and practices. Engage with Māori experts and community leaders to ensure authentic representation.

TAMARIKI CENTRIC-TAKARO ENHANCED APPROACH

Establish tamariki voice to provide ongoing input into tākaro programs. Ensure that their perspectives shape the design and implementation of activities.

TECHNOLOGICAL INTEGRATION ENHANCED APPROACH

Create hybrid play experiences that blend technology with physical activity. Ensure that technology enhances, rather than replaces, traditional play and fosters engagement.

NATURE & ENVIRONMENT ENHANCED APPROACH

Integrate environmental stewardship into tākaro activities. Create programs that teach tamariki about sustainability and their role in protecting natural spaces.

COMMUNITY AND SOCIAL IMPACT ENHANCED APPROACH

Develop community-driven initiatives that tailor tākaro experiences to local needs and contexts. Foster neighborhood play events and community-led projects to enhance social connections.

IMPLEMENTATION STRATEGIES

- Conduct comprehensive mapping of tākaro resources and opportunities across the region.
- Use this data to inform strategic planning and resource allocation
- Develop targeted strategies to address barriers to play for underserved groups.
- Use funding to support projects that specifically enhance accessibility and inclusivity.
- Launch educational campaigns that highlight the benefits of tākaro.
- Provide resources and training for parents, caregivers, and educators on the value of play and how to support it effectively.
- Engage in advocacy efforts to ensure that tākaro is a priority in regional and national policy. Collaborate with policymakers to develop supportive frameworks and secure funding.

EVALUATION AND ADAPTATION

- Establish a robust evaluation framework to regularly assess the impact of takaro initiatives.
- Use findings to make data-driven adjustments and continuously improve programs and policies.

SUCCESS STORIES AND CASE STUDIES

- Document and disseminate success stories and case studies that highlight the impact of tākaro initiatives.
